GRAHAM CAPTURES WALDEN AWARD

The most prestigious award presented by the Calgary Construction Association is the Ted Walden Award, in honour of CCA's first President in 1944.

Gord Graham, the Ted Walden recipient was surprised to say the least, when CCA's Senior Vice-President, Ken Trueman made the announcement at the association's fifty-second Annual General Meeting. The construction industry is very appreciative of Gord's commitment to better the industry. "There is not a committee that he has not served on at one time or other" stated Trueman. For several years, he was a Director of CCA, and elected President in 1983. Gord went on to become the Chairman of the Alberta Construction Association and also Chairman of Construction Labour Relations, an Alberta Association. For several years, he also participated at the national level as a Director of the Canadian Construction Association. In receiving the plaque, Gord was taken back for a moment or two, however he managed to say a few words. Gord noted his father Ron Graham, who was in attendance, had taken over Hurst Construction in the early fifties, Ted Walden and

Gord started with Hurst following his graduation as a Civil Engineer from the University of Alberta in 1970, his brother Dave followed shortly thereafter his graduation in 1977. Gord has received his Gold Seal Certification for Estimating and Project Management.
